



POSITION OPEN ADITEC PROJECT MANAGER

The Sclavo Vaccines Association (SVA) is a non-profit organization devoted to support vaccine research and development based in Siena (Italy). The overall aim of the Association is to advance vaccine development through the identification and application of novel technologies, as well as enhancing European competitiveness in vaccine science by promoting innovation in the area of vaccines. To reach its goals the Association has gathered 12 leading institutions from 7 European countries in the vaccine field.

The Association is today engaged in the coordination of 3 major EU funded projects aimed at accelerating development and clinical assessment of immunization technologies and candidate vaccines. SVA is the Coordinator of the FP7 High Impact Project *Advanced Immunization Technologies* (ADITEC) .

ADITEC (www.aditecproject.eu) is a collaborative research program that aims to accelerate the development of novel and powerful immunization technologies for the next generation of human vaccines. Scientists from 13 countries and 42 research partners collaborate in the ADITEC project. ADITEC comprises some of the most advanced European research groups in vaccinology from universities, research institutions and biotech companies together with top US groups on systems biology and adjuvants. Different aspects of vaccination, from new technologies to clinical trials and public health, are covered. ADITEC started in October 2011, is a 5-year project and has received funding from the European Union's Seventh Programme for research, under grant agreement No280873.
