Main tasks:

- Closely cooperate with Scientific Coordinator to organize and implement all scientific/technical and activities inherent to the management of EU-funded vaccine research programmes;
- Organise annual, cluster, experts, and other programme meetings;
- Take an operational lead in monitoring and reporting activities;
- Liaise with project external stakeholders;
- Serve as operational focal point for central project activities like running the programme's Ethical Experts Committee;
- Serve as operational focal point interactions with EU services;
- Serve as operational focal point for consultancies to be contracted to conduct defined programme tasks.
